

THE MACE AND THE PRESIDENT'S JEWEL OF OFFICE

Maces have been a symbol of authority since medieval times. IU's mace, which the university grand marshal carries, is embossed with the seal of the university and the seal of the state of Indiana.



The pendant worn by President Whitten at all formal ceremonies, known as the President's Jewel, is rich in meaning. Its

design is inspired by the arbutus, the university flower. Three precious stones represent reading, writing, and arithmetic, and another three, the arts, sciences, and humanities.
